Clothing

- Shower shoes / flip flops (keep your feet off shower floor)
- Jacket (rain jacket best)
- Heavy Shirt (wool) or Sweatshirt (hooded)(just in case)
- Official Boy Scout Uniform (CLASS A)- wear each night at dinner.
- Shirt with proper insignia
- Class B uniform (3 shirts minimum recommend)
- Neckerchief & slide or bolo
- Scout Shorts - several (2-4)
- Scout Belt
- Scout socks (3-5 pair)
- Scout Cap (optional)
- Hiking Boots or shoes / sneakers
- Underwear (6 prs)
- Socks (6 prs)
- Swim Trunks & Swim Towel (extra optional)
- Swim goggles (optional)
- Poncho / Raincoat with Hood or Hat
- Sneakers
- Spare shoe laces (optional)

Misc.

- Boy Scout Handbook - packed in Ziplock bag
- Money (Food up, Food back, spending @ Camp)
- Merit Badge Pamphlets & any Homework for Merit Badges
- Spiral or loose leaf notebook & pens / pencils
- Clothespins & 2 plastic hangars
- Snack foods
- Heavy duty trash Plastic bags (to 'waterproof' packs & bags)
- Extra Zip-Lock bag for papers, pens, merit badges
- Footlocker or Trunk
- Sleeping Bag (liner optional but useful)
- Sheet for hot weather
- Insect Repellant
- Sun shield lotion
- Soap in soap dish & unbreakable mirror
- Comb or brush
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Towels (2) & washcloth
- Medications prescribed by MD
- Deodorant
- Good flashlights & spare batteries & matching spare bulb
- Spare eyeglasses & case (or contacts & cleaning supplies)
- "Croakie" or other floating glasses strap (if eyeglasses)
- Stamped & Addressed envelope & paper for home (must write home once)
- Watch
- Camera & film
- Mosquito netting for bunk, duct tape, (4) ½" dowels and (4) tennis balls

- ___ 12 ft of clothes line or rope.
- ___ Pillow, blanket
- ___ Water container personal type
- ___ ADULT : coffee mug / folding chair / reading material / comfy stuff
- ___ Compass
- ___ Fishing poles & lures
- ___ Sharp folding knife & toten' chip card
- ___ Sunglasses
- ___ 1st aid kit & mole skin for feet
- ___ Small daypack is handy for notebooks & merit badge books, pens etc.

DO NOT BRING the following:

NO! - CD players, Radio, TV, cell phones etc.. (except for trip to/from camp)

NO! - Fireworks, matches, etc...

NO! - Long knives & sheath (only folding) or Hatchets

NO! - Excess amounts of Candy

NOTES :

1) All gear should be labeled with YOUR FULL NAME : esp. underwear & socks

2) Swimming & Lifesaving merit badge : need long-sleeve shirt & long pants (not scout shirt)

3) Pack snack foods in metal containers (mice, chipmunks can get in otherwise)

4) All medications must be properly labeled in containers prepared **by your physician or pharmacist**, and be identified to the Scoutmaster BEFORE we depart for camp.
